## AGE GROUP CHAMPIONSHIPS 2015 SPECTATOR INFORMATION

- All spectator seats overlooking the Competition pool ONLY will be numbered- spectators will be given a ticket upon entry with their seat number on – Seat Tickets are for EACH session and will be colour coded per session - ALL spectators must be present at the time of entry to receive a ticket
  - Swimmers are not permitted on the balcony at any time
    - Fold up chairs are not permitted on the balcony
- The queue for the merchandise will open at the START of the last warm up for each session- queuing will not be permitted before this time
- Disabled seats can be booked in advance by emailing <a href="mailto:essexswimming@btopenworld.com">essexswimming@btopenworld.com</a>. These seats will be in the disabled seating area ONLY
- The balcony will be totally cleared between sessions- any belongings left will be placed along the back wall
- The queue for the Spectator Gallery will be directed along the Gallery of the Athletic track therefore there will be some outside queuing
  - Verbal abuse directed at our Volunteers will not be tolerated at any time and offenders may be asked to leave
  - If you have a seat numbered ticket and leave before the end of the session please offer your tickets to someone else who is standing

## SWIMMERS INFORMATION

ALL clubs will be allocated a space on poolside

- Entry to poolside will be 10 minutes before the first Warm up for ALL swimmers & Coaches for ALL sessions (except the 2nd session when there are 2 sessions in the day)
  - Swimmers will not be permitted on the balcony at any time
    - Fold Up Chairs are not permitted on the poolside
    - Swimmers must swim in their permitted warm up ONLY
- Swimmers can warm up at any time in the Swim Down Pool once the competition has started in Lanes 1-4 ONLY
  - ALL swimmers must report to the marshalling area before their event
- Relay events do not report to the marshalling area- these remain the Coaches responsibility
- If a swimmer 'forgets to sign in this MUST be reported to the results area before the start of that event- If a lane is available they will be permitted on a first come first served basis to swim in the first heat
